

Floss Friendship Bracelet

Weave a friendship bracelet using embroidery floss.

Learn the [basic knot first](#) and try your hands at the diagonal stripe.

You need:

- 4 Colors of Embroidery Floss 25" Long
- Masking Tape

Instructions:

Tie Knot about 1-1/2" from the top. Tape knotted end to a table or the back of a chair. Separate the strands by color, as shown.

The Basic Knot You've got to learn this first to get started.

Take two different colored strings, tie them together at one end and tape them down.

As they hang side-by-side, roll the string on the right, the right-hand string passes over, back. The other one, call the left-hand string.

The Basic Knot

1. Hold the right-hand string right and knot the other around it.

2. Pull toward the left and pull snug.

3. Repeat so you have a double knot.

4. This is the knot going LEFT TO RIGHT. Repeat on double knots.

Going the Other Way

1. Hold the left-hand string right and knot the other around it.

2. Pull toward the right and pull snug.

3. Repeat so you have a double knot.

4. This is the knot going RIGHT TO LEFT. Repeat on double knots.

1. Start with string 1 and loop it over and then under string 2. Hold string 3 straight (this is upper part) and pull the knot snug.

2. Do step 1 a second time so you have a double knot.

3. Now take string 4 and make double knots around each of the remaining strands (3 and 4). This is the string you'll be working with soon.

4. Now do the same thing again. Start with the far left strand 3 and do double knots, left to right, all the way across the other colors.

5. Keep going until the bracelet is as long as you would like.

6. Gather the strings and tie a knot to secure. Trim the ends to about




The Basic Knot

You've got to learn this first to get started.


Take two different colored strings, tie them together at one end and tape them down.

As they hang side-by-side, call the string on the right, the right-hand string (makes sense, huh?). The other one, call the left-hand string.

1 Hold the right-hand string tight and knot the other around it.



2 Pull toward the left and pull snug.



3 Repeat so you have a double knot.




4 This is the knot going LEFT TO RIGHT




Always tie double knots

The Basic Knot Going the Other Way


1 Hold the left-hand string tight and knot the other around it.




2 Pull toward the right and pull snug.



3 Repeat so you have a double knot.



4 This is the knot going RIGHT TO LEFT



Always tie double knots

Start with string 1 and loop it over and then under string 2. Hold string 2 straight (this is important) and pull the knot snug.

Do step 1 a second time so you have a double knot.

Now take string 1 and make double knots around each of the remaining strands (3 and 4), left



This is the string you'll be working with next.

Now do the same thing again. Start with the far left strand 2 and tie double knots, left to right, all the way across the other colors.

Keep going until the bracelet is as long as you would like.
